



Topic: **Reservoir Committee Agenda Item 8-2** **2019 August 22**

Subject: **Evaluation Panel’s Recommendation – Service Area HC – Engineering Services – Conveyance**

Requested Action:

Consider approval of the selection panel’s recommendation to conditionally select Jacobs Engineering Group (Jacobs) for Service Area HC – Engineering (Conveyance) and to recommend the Sites Project Authority Board of Directors consider authorizing the General manager to enter into negotiations with Jacobs.

Detailed Description/Background:

The Authority solicited Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) in support of Service Area HC – Engineering (Conveyance). SOQs were submitted by Black and Veatch, and Jacobs. The Evaluation Panel, advisors, and staff reviewed and evaluated both SOQs in detail. Based on those evaluations Black and Veatch and Jacobs were invited to interview with the Evaluation Panel and present their qualifications, staff and approach.

On August 14, 2019, each respondent made separate presentations and answered questions posed by the Evaluation Panel. After the interviews, the Evaluation Panel discussed the merits of each respondents’ presentations and SOQs.

Recommendation:

Based on the evaluation of the submitted SOQs and the interviews, the Evaluation Panel unanimously recommends the Reservoir Committee and Sites Project Authority each authorize staff to enter into discussions with Jacobs for a contract to support the Authority and Committee in the Engineering (Conveyance), aka Service Area HC.
